### **REQUEST DETAILS:**

Request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

1. Please provide a copy of the January 1973 Conveyancing Deed of Sale between Bradford Property Trust and Suffolk Police Authority regarding Martlesham Heath HQ location] and the covenants associated with it.
2. I understand that plans for the Martlesham Heath Police Headquarters site are focused on an active assessment of efficiency options within Suffolk Constabulary's Medium-Term Financial Plan and Police & Crime Plan and that the force is analysing different choices.

Please provide information on the current status, what options are being considered, meeting notes etc. and if reuse or sharing with another public body is being considered.
