Total Recorded Crime	7,014	Down 14%
Violence with Injury – crimes	729	Down 13%
Violence with Injury – solved rate	57%	Up 0.5%
Domestic burglary – crimes	416	Down 20%
Domestic burglary – solved rate	24%	Down 3.2%
Robbery – crimes	51	Down 19%
Robbery – solved rate	43%	Up 11%
Serious sexual offences – solved rate	14%	Down 13%
Rowdy/inconsiderate ASB incidents	3,011	Down 26%
999 calls answered within 10 seconds	94.8%	Up 4.2%
101 calls answered within 20 seconds	88.1%	Up 5.5%
Emergency incidents attended within 15 minutes	90.4%	Down 0.9%
Victims satisfied with experience	85.6%	Up 4.5%



- Waveney's lowest crime rate in a decade
- Lowest rates of violent crime, sexual offences and robbery in five years
- Lowest burglary rate in four years
- Vehicle crime halved and criminal damage reduced by 44% in six years.
