- Inspector Shipton talked about the range of work the police were doing to protect the people of Suffolk. He touched on a number of areas from targeting speeding hotspots to the less obvious work such as preventing drug trafficking and the work of the Cyber-crime unit.
- A member of the public explained that parking in Church Walk is an ongoing problem with the walk blocked at one end. Inspector Shipton advised the SNT was well aware of the problems and, where possible, the SNT would patrol.
- It was also mentioned that from time to time there was minor theft from the church building. The member of the public explained that this is not always reported. The Inspector suggested that every crime, no matter how small, should be reported.
