

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

REQUEST NUMBER: 10 - 2022

REQUEST DETAILS:

1. What correspondence has Tim Passmore and Greg Songer received from Peter Aldous MP, MP for Waveney and Michael Ladd, County Councillor for Kessingland and Southwold, in relation to the Gateway Retail Park and Kessingland Bypass. I am asking from 1st January 2022 please. What I mean by correspondence is the following: E-Mails, WhatsApp Messages, Letters, Agendas and Minutes of Meetings, Memos.
2. How much has Tim Passmore agreed to contribute towards an average speed camera for the Kessingland Bypass?
3. How many incidents of speeding or Road Traffic Collisions have been reported for Castleton Avenue and Lowestoft Road in Carlton Colville please. I am asking from 1st January 2017 please.

RESPONSE

1. The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Suffolk (OPCC) has no formal records of any correspondence between the named parties within this request that relate to the topic of the Gateway Retail Park and Kessingland Bypass within the time frame stipulated. This relates to all OPCC individuals included within this request.
2. The Police and Crime Commissioner has not agreed to contribute any funds towards an average speed camera on the Kessingland bypass at this stage. All request for funding of this nature would be evaluated on evidence-based needs with funding being split between road safety partners.
3. This request is being responded to by the Suffolk Constabulary Freedom of Information department directly.
