## **REQUEST DETAILS:**

I would like to make the following request under the Freedom of Information Act:

Does the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner current fund any support services for victims of non-criminal anti-social behaviour in the police force area?

If yes, please can you provide details of the service commissioned, including the funding provided and how many victims were supported last year.

## **RESPONSE**

The Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) commissions Anglia Care Trust to provide a mediation service (police referrals) for victims of anti-social behaviour in Suffolk.

The value of this contract for the initial term of three years (commencing 1 April 2023) is £57,819.

In 2023/24 the service received 56 referrals (comprising 142 individuals) and engaged and supported 98 new individuals.

The PCC multi-crime service, Norfolk and Suffolk Victim Care, also support victims of Anti-social behaviour.

Although the service is primarily for victims of crime, the PCC is aware that non-crime ASB may also have occurred. This service is jointly commissioned by the PCCs for Norfolk and Suffolk.

We are not able to supply the number of non-crimes ASB victims supported by the service for the last year.
